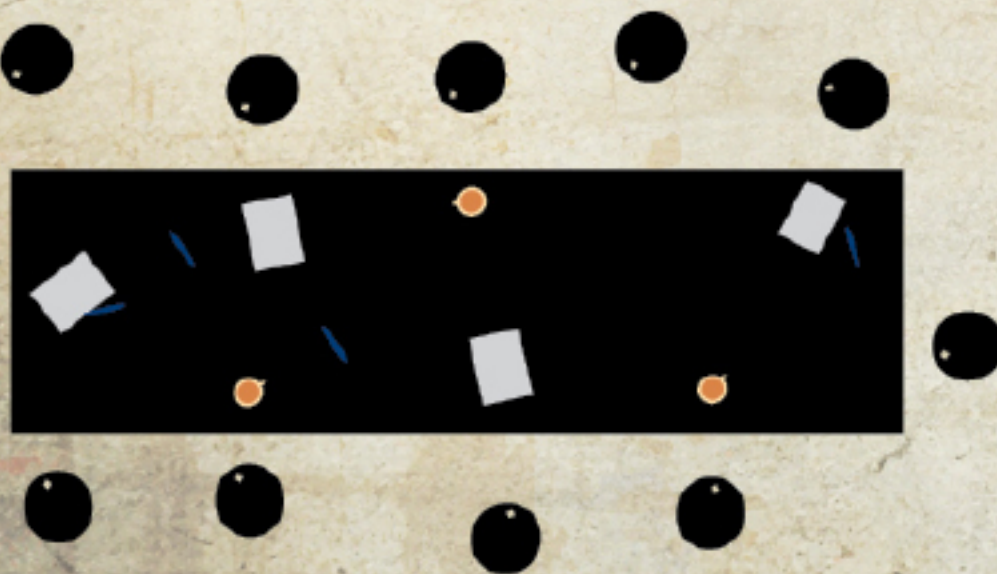


58th National Film Awards
